Hello, and thank you for Inquiring about a Rutlands puppy, the most sought after in the world. This Information Pack covers practical things you need to know, such as pricing of puppies. But we also understand that the decision you are about to make is an emotional one which will impact you and your family for many years to come. So we hope this info pack also conveys the dedication and love that permeates the way we keep our dogs, raise their puppies, and the commitment we feel towards our puppies' families.

At Rutlands Australian Cobberdogs, we are proud of what we do, and we value transparency which is why our Facebook page is set to public. This way you are welcome to contact others across the world who already have their Rutlands dogs or puppies and who will be happy to share their Rutlands experience with you!

- Your Rutlands Australian Cobberdog puppy is carefully selected to be as close a perfect match as possible, to you and your family's individual lifestyle and situation.
- On your application you may choose Miniature, Medium or Standard size, bearing in mind that with live creatures there is no absolute and size variations can occur. You may request gender, color and coat type of your puppy, but if we believe that a different puppy will be a better match, we will offer you this puppy and explain the reasons why. You are welcome to defer to another litter if you prefer to wait and your booking fee will hold good for up to two years although the price may rise in that time..
- Coat color and nature are not size related.
- Nature is not gender related in this breed

YOUR SITUATION IS UNIQUE AND SO IS YOUR PUPPY

Our puppies are usually booked before they are born, but they are not allocated on a first come-first served basis only. Each puppy is an individual as are you and your family. If there are not enough puppies to satisfy our wait list, and more than one family will be *best match* for one of our puppies, then the date each application is confirmed by payment of the booking fee will decide who is next in turn for their new family member.

Your puppy is born inside our home, with quiet "music for mothers-to-be" playing and one or more of us lovingly watching over each tiny new life as it enters the world. Mama Cobberdog appreciates our presence while we keep her nest clean and cosy for this big event.

PAYMENT PLAN

- Non refundable booking fee of \$500 confirms your place on the waiting list. This is deducted from the price of your puppy
- Progress Payment of \$500 when the litter holding your puppy is born
- 2nd Progress Payment of \$500 at four weeks of age
- Final payment includes travel if applicable and must be paid 14 business days before the puppy is picked up or leaves. Payments may be invoiced by direct bank transfer or PayPal.

TRAVEL AND COMING HOME

If you are not able to pick up your puppy in person, there is no need to be concerned. Rutlands puppies are bred for stable temperament and receive crate training and extensive socialization and travel preparation so that they accept their trip to their forever homes as just another event in their young lives.

We have extensive experience since 1998 in shipping puppies across Australia and around the world and over time we've developed a successful and proven conditioning program which ensures your puppy will be well prepared for the journey and will arrive unaffected by his/her travel adventure. A door to door puppy taxi may also be arranged if you prefer a road trip for your new baby – NT and WA excluded. In Australia, your puppy can come home to you between nine and ten weeks of age.

HEALTH AND WARRANTY

You should take your puppy for a full physical examination at your own vet within 48 hours of the arrival of the puppy into your home. Your vet will provide you with the appropriate information regarding worming schedules, vaccinations and treatments pertinent to the area you live.

COUNCIL REGISTRATION

Under the mandates of the Australian Code of Practice, we are required to inform you that that you are required by law to register the puppy with your own relevant shire council as soon as he/she turns three months of age. We will provide you with the transfer paperwork for this purpose.
